Sub: Electricity Tariff revision proposals for the year 2014-2015

Dear Sir,

We wish to know your view on moving the Hon'ble High Court for a stay of the 'suo-motu' tariff revision proposals of TNERC for the year 2014-2015.

1. We have sought from TNERC the ARR and related data for the proposals vide our letter No.TECA:2014-15/DB/TNERC-35 dated October 7, 2014. We are not hopeful that these data would be made available in time for us to make a proper representation to TNERC before the due date, i.e., 23.10.2014.
2. We are also planning to make another request to TNERC for data this week which is needed by the consultants engaged by us to prepare the representation.
3. We have sought some data on 09.10.2014 from TANGEDCO by a RTI petition on its Financial Restructuring Plan. This data is also needed for our representation on the tariff proposals.
4. We enclose a note from Mr. D H Hanumantha Rao, Former Member TNERC, on the proposals. He has suggested that TNERC should punish TANGEDCO / TANTRANSCO by extending the validity of its 2013 Tariff orders till 31.03.2016, and also levying a time on TANGEDCO / TANTRANSCO. He further suggests that 2 of the three members of TNERC should be recuse themselves from the tariff proceedings their decisions as employees of TANGEDCO / TANTRANSCO, to be dealt in the tariff proceedings.
5. TANGEDCO / TANTRANSCO's tariff revision proposals for the year 2015- 2016 are due by 30.11.2014. It is likely that they would also be done in a similar method.
6. We believe that you had a preliminary discussion on this matter with some other associations.
7. We await your views on how to proceed further in this matter.
