Dear Sir,

Sub: O&M Charges on windmills-Will not be claimed through CC bills from November 2020 onwards-Will be claimed by separate invoice by TANTRANSCO with GST-Regarding.

Members having WEGs / Solar Power Plants are informed that from November 2020 onwards, the O&M charges hither to collected on the WEGs / Solar Power Plants through CC bills, will not be included in the CC bills and the same will not find place in the AMR / Generation Statement. TANTRANSCO has decided to collect all TANTRANSCO related charges hereafter separately, by raising separate invoices. To start with the program, they have now introduced it to O&M charges at the first phase.

Accordingly, TANTRANSCO will make the window opened for uploading the GST details of wind energy generators / Solar Power Generators and once this process of uploading GSTIN is completed, the TANTRANSCO will issue the invoices on O&M charges on windmills with GST of 18%. Those members, who are making use of the wind / solar energy for captive consumption, can take ITC credit on the GST paid amount and accordingly, they can avail the GST paid amount, for discharging their own GST obligations. Members will be alerted once the window is ready for uploading the GSTIN details.

Likewise, within another two months, the TANTRANSCO will separate the below charges, from not found in the CC bills anymore and a separate project is being promoted as SAMAST and once it is implemented, all the following charges now collected through CC bills, will be separated from CC bills raised by TANGEDCO and will be collected through separate invoices with GST wherever applicable.

- 1. Scheduling and System Operation Charges
- 2. Reactive Power Charges (kVARh)
- 3. Transmission Charges
- 4. DSM compensation if comes for full implementation
- 5. and any other charges notified by TANTRANSCO

Therefore, members are requested to take note of the above changes proposed and more particularly, the O&M charges now delisted from the CC bills / TANGEDCO charges. In the absence of failure of payment of such separate invoices will be dealt with under Section 56 of the Electricity Act 2003 and if the default continues beyond 15 days, supply of electricity may be disconnected.
