Sub: Madras High Court Order: Withdrawal of 'Deemed Demand Benefit' by TANGEDCO.

Ref: The Judgment of Madras High Court dated 14.09.2018 in a Batch of Writ Petitions.

In continuation to our Circular No.54. Dtd 28.09.2018. We wish to inform our members that, The Hon'ble High Court of Judicature at Madras has quashed the communication of CFC-Revenue made in Memo No. CFC/FC/DFC/<u>AAO.HT/AS.3/REV/</u> D.N.115/13 dated 29.07.2013 on 14.09.2018 in the matter of withdrawing the Deemed Demand Benefit.

* * * * *

Few TECA members has challenged this matter by filing individual Writ Petitions and got an interim stay. Those members paying 50% based on earlier court order and also those members paying in full for want of Court orders, Every OA consumer is eligible to claim the Deemed Demand Benefit.

Members may approach SE to allow Deemed Demand Benefit to the extent of 100% from CC bills for September 2018 onwards. They can send a letter to SE as per the specimen attached. It should be noted that even the TANGEDCO goes for an appeal, providing a letter as per the specimen is must.
